



Information You Provide

Some activities on this website require us to collect personally identifiable information. These activities include contacting eviCore, getting personalized directions to the offices or signing up for e-mail mailing lists. Personal information is collected when you provide information to complete a form on the websites. For many activities, we only collect your e-mail address. For other activities, including using the contact request form, we may also collect additional more specific information.

Information Collected via Technology

eviCore collects information about website visitors using standard Internet technology. Your IP address along with general log information may be collected when you visit this website for statistical purposes only. We also uses cookies for a variety of purposes to enhance the user experience.

Cookie Definition

A cookie is a simple line of text that a web server asks your browser to remember for future use. A typical cookie may store your user name and password for a specific site on the web.

There are two kinds of cookies. A session cookie is a line of text that is stored temporarily in your computer's memory. Because a session cookie is never written to a drive, it is destroyed as soon as you close your browser. A persistent cookie is a more permanent line of text that gets saved by your browser to a file on your hard drive. Websites cannot make direct changes to your local cookies file; only your browser can do that. Your browser has security features built in which prevent servers from randomly writing information to your hard drive. You can turn off the cookie feature in your browser. Please check your browser's help files on how to do this. When the cookie feature is on, server information can only be written to your local cookie file. The web server that writes the cookie is the only one that can read that cookie according to Microsoft Server documentation.

How Do We Use the Information We Collect?

We use the information we collect for specific purposes. If you contact us for assistance, we will use your information to contact you. If you subscribe to our email newsletter, we will use your email address to send you appropriate email updates and newsletters on occasion. eviCore does not share your information with any other third party under any circumstances. Every email newsletter from eviCore will include a link that, when clicked, will instantly unsubscribe you from the email list.
