Medicare defines services as reasonable and necessary when they lead to any of the following:

- Diagnosis or treatment of an illness
- Diagnosis or treatment of an injury
- Improvement of the functionality of a malformed body member

When making medical necessity determinations for Medicare members, eviCore will employ the following strategy for both utilization management case reviews and automated claim edit application:

- Medicare Benefit Policy Manual
- National Coverage Determinations (NCDs)
- Local Coverage Determinations (LCDs and LCAs)
- Proprietary guidelines including
 - \circ MCGTM evidence-based Care Guidelines[®]
 - eviCore guidelines
- Society/Peer reviewed literature
