



## **Continuity of Care (COC) Process for DME Providers**

## Medicare Advantage Only

## **Continuity of Care Defined**

A prior authorization was approved for a date span that carried over from 2018 through 2019. Member was enrolled in a Medicare cost plan and changed insurance to Medicare Advantage. Member has continuous rental history of DME product for the following circumstances:

- 1. Patient is on continuous oxygen prior to the implementation of eviCore.
- 2. Ventilators and supplies with prior medical history.
- 3. Hospital Beds, wheelchairs and other DME equipment with continuous rental history.

## eviCore COC Process for DME Reviews

- DME vendors are required to submit attached COC spreadsheet with all fields completed to eviCore attention: Alana.Humphries@evicore.com
- eviCore will review the information for accuracy and build the appropriate DME case, based upon the COC information
- eviCore will provide authorization numbers and details to the DME provider on spreadsheet when completed
- DME providers will receive a written approval letter to the fax number provided with coversheet explaining COC approval
- DME provider can then submit claims as needed for ongoing DME supplies
