Effective January 1, 2022, precertification for the gastroenterology procedures listed below will be included in the list of outpatient services requiring precertification for most Cigna commercial (non-Medicare) customers whose plan requires outpatient precertification.

- Esophagoscopy/Esophagogastroduodenoscopy (EGD)
- Most capsule endoscopies

Our goal is to help ensure that these tests and procedures are medically necessary according to evidence-based guidelines. We have delegated precertification of these procedures to eviCore healthcare (eviCore). eviCore's specially trained nurses and gastroenterologists will use evidence-based guidelines to determine medical necessity.

Precertification process

eviCore will begin taking precertification requests on January 1, 2022.*

The preferred and most efficient method for submitting precertification requests is through eviCore's website (eviCore.com). If you are not a registered user, you can go to eviCore.com > Register Now.

While we encourage you to submit requests through the website, you can also request precertification by calling eviCore at **866.668.9250** (7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. local time).
