Sleep	95782	Polysomnography; younger than 6 years, sleep staging with 4 or more additional parameters of sleep, attended by a technologist
Sleep	95783	Polysomnography; younger than 6 years, sleep staging with 4 or more additional parameters of sleep, with initiation of continuous positive airway pressure therapy or bi-level ventilation, attended by a technologist
Sleep	95800	Sleep study, unattended, simultaneous recording; heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory analysis (eg, by airflow or peripheral arterial tone), and sleep time
Sleep	95801	Sleep study, unattended, simultaneous recording; minimum of heart rate, oxygen saturation, and respiratory analysis (eg, by airflow or peripheral arterial tone)
Sleep	95805	Multiple sleep latency or maintenance of wakefulness testing, recording, analysis and interpretation of physiological measurements of sleep during multiple trials to assess sleepiness
Sleep	95806	Sleep study, unattended, simultaneous recording of, heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory airflow, and respiratory effort (eg, thoracoabdominal movement)
Sleep	95807	Sleep study, simultaneous recording of ventilation, respiratory effort, ECG or heart rate, and oxygen saturation, attended by a technologist
Sleep	95808	Polysomnography; any age, sleep staging with 1-3 additional parameters of sleep, attended by a technologist
Sleep	95810	Polysomnography; age 6 years or older, sleep staging with 4 or more additional parameters of sleep, attended by a technologist
Sleep	95811	Polysomnography; age 6 years or older, sleep staging with 4 or more additional parameters of sleep, with initiation of continuous positive airway pressure therapy or bilevel ventilation, attended by a technologist
Sleep	A4604	Tubing with integrated heating element for use with positive airway pressure device
Sleep	A7027	Combination oral/nasal mask, used with continuous positive airway pressure device, each
Sleep	A7028	Oral cushion for combination oral/nasal mask, replacement only, each
Sleep	A7029	Nasal pillows for combination oral/nasal mask, replacement only, pair
Sleep	A7030	Full face mask used with positive airway pressure device, each
Sleep	A7031	Face mask interface, replacement for full face mask, each
Sleep	A7032	Cushion for use on nasal mask interface, replacement only, each
Sleep	A7033	Pillow for use on nasal cannula type interface, replacement only, pair

Sleep	A7045	Exhalation port with or without swivel used with accessories for positive airway devices, replacement only
Sleep	A7046	Water chamber for humidifier, used with positive airway pressure device, replacement, each
Sleep	A9270	Non-covered item or service (Used for oral appliances that do not incorporate all of the criteria as set forth in the Policy Article; tongue-retaining or tongue-positioning devices; and devices that are used only to treat snoring without a diagnosis of obstructive sleep apnea)
Sleep	E0470	Respiratory assist device, bi-level pressure capability, without backup rate feature, used with noninvasive interface, e.g., nasal or facial mask (intermittent assist device with continuous positive airway pressure device)
Sleep	E0471	Respiratory assist device, bi-level pressure capability, with back-up rate feature, used with noninvasive interface, e.g., nasal or facial mask (intermittent assist device with continuous positive airway pressure device)
Sleep	E0485	Oral device/appliance used to reduce upper airway collapsibility, adjustable or non-adjustable, prefabricated, includes fitting and adjustment
Sleep	E0486	Oral device/appliance used to reduce upper airway collapsibility, adjustable or non-adjustable, custom fabricated, includes fitting and adjustment
Sleep	E0492	Power source and control electronics unit for oral device/appliance for neuromuscular electrical stimulation of the tongue muscle, controlled by phone application
Sleep	E0493	Oral device/appliance for neuromuscular electrical stimulation of the tongue muscle, used in conjunction with the power source and control electronics unit, controlled by phone application, 90-day supply
Sleep	E0561	Humidifier, non-heated, used with positive airway pressure device
Sleep	E0562	Humidifier, heated, used with positive airway pressure device
Sleep	E0601	Continuous positive airway pressure (cpap) device
Sleep	G0398	Home sleep study test (hst) with type ii portable monitor, unattended; minimum of 7 channels: eeg, eog, emg, ecg/heart rate, airflow, respiratory effort and oxygen saturation
Sleep	G0399	Home sleep test (hst) with type iii portable monitor, unattended; minimum of 4 channels: 2 respiratory movement/airflow, 1 ecg/heart rate and 1 oxygen saturation
Sleep	G0400	Home sleep test (hst) with type iv portable monitor, unattended; minimum of 3 channels
Sleep	K1027	Oral device/appliance used to reduce upper airway collapsibility, without fixed mechanical hinge, custom fabricated, includes fitting and adjustment

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
